A question mark goes at the end of a question. A question is something you ask when you want to know something.





- Can I have a drink?
- Where is my teddy?



What is an Exclamation Mark?

The end of a loud or exciting sentence.

It shows strong feelings like surprise, happiness, anger, or excitement.

■ We use an exclamation mark like this: !

Examples:

- Wow, that's amazing!
- Stop that!
- I love ice cream!
- Help!
