


YEAR 2 ENGLISH: Grammar Worksheets



An adverb is a word that tells us how, when, or where something happens.

Examples:

- She sings loudly. \rightarrow (How does she sing? Loudly)
- I will go home later. \rightarrow (When will I go? Later)
- The kids are playing outside. → (Where are they playing? Outside)
- Quick Tip: Adverbs = Add to the verb!


