A noun is a word that names a person, a place, or a thing.

If you can see it, touch it, visit it, or name it — it's probably a noun!



Common nouns are general names for people, places, or things. They do not start with a capital letter (unless at the start of a sentence).

Examples: The girl played with her dog at the park.

# 👪 2. Proper Nouns

Proper nouns are the special names of people, places, or things. They always start with a capital letter.

Examples: Liam went to Melbourne on Sunday.

🍒 3. Plural Nouns

Plural nouns are nouns that mean more than one. We usually add -s, -es, or change the word to make it plural.

Example: The dogs barked at the buses full of children.




