Let's learn how to build strong, clear sentences!

What is SVO?

SVO stands for:

- ✓ Subject - Who or what the sentence is about
- ✓ Verb - The action (what is being done)
- ✓ Object - What or who is receiving the action

🎯 SVO Makes a Sentence Clear

This structure helps us:

- Know who is doing the action
- Know what action is happening
- Know who or what the action is done to

1.. Tom eats the sandwich. (Missing subject – any person or thing works here)



Other possible answers: She, Dad, The boy

2. The bird ate the worm. (Missing verb – action word)



Other possible answers: pecked, found, saw

3. Emma reads a book. (Missing object – what she reads)



Other possible answers: the newspaper, her homework, a story

4. Liam painted the wall. (Any part can be added – here the subject is filled)



Other options:

- Subject: My sister painted the wall.
- Verb: He splashed the wall.
- Object: She painted the fence.
