

YEAR 3 ENGLISH: Grammar Worksheets

Tense in grammar tells us when something happens – in the past, present, or future.



Tense = Time of Action

Past Tense - tells about something that already happened.

Example: I played soccer yesterday.

Present Tense - tells about something that is happening now.

Example: I play soccer every day.

Future Tense - tells about something that will happen later.

Example: I will play soccer tomorrow.






