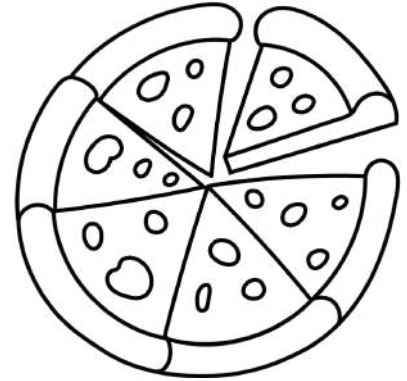

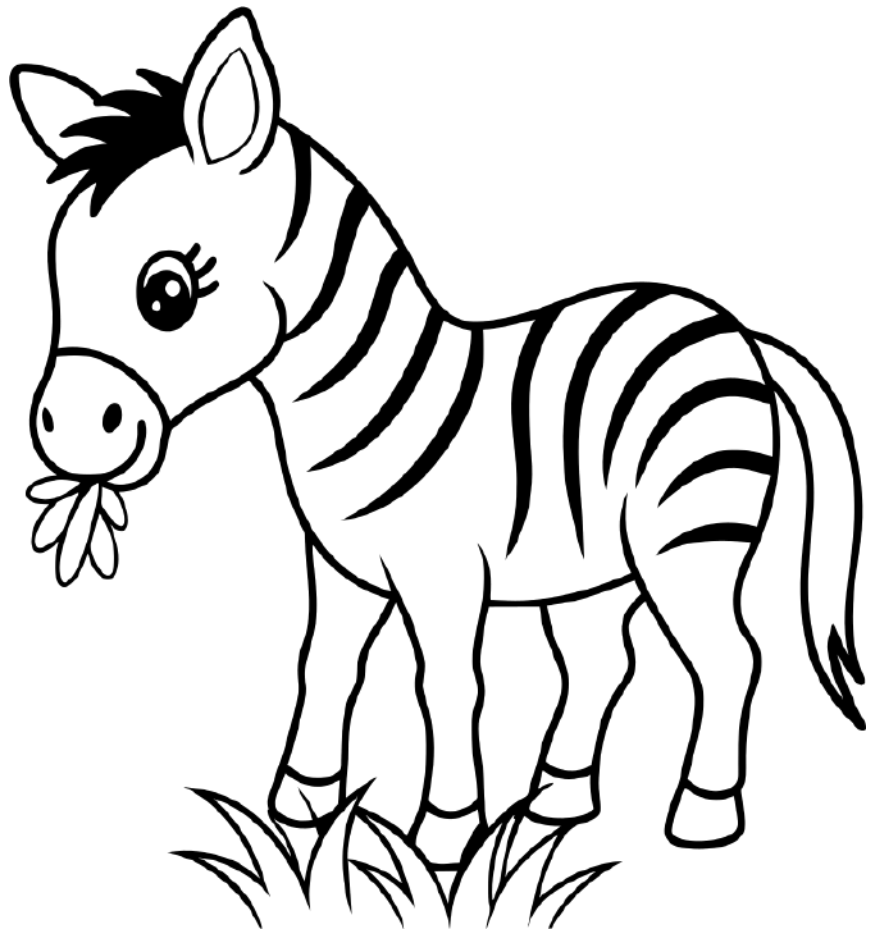

Activity 4: Quick Write – Yes or No?
