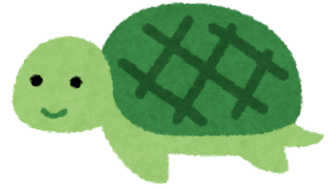


TILLY THE TURTLE'S BIG JOURNEY

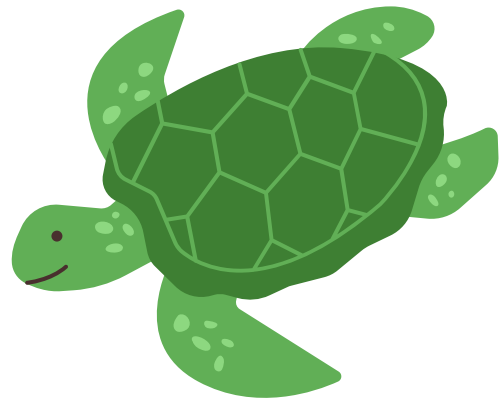

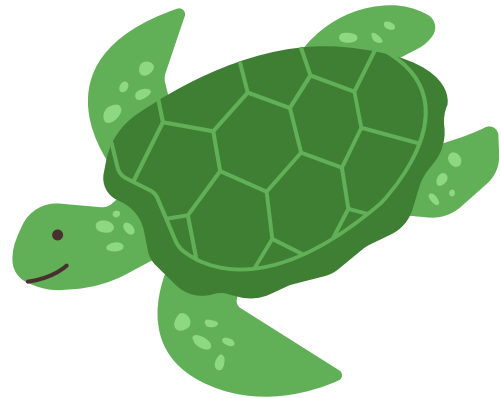
