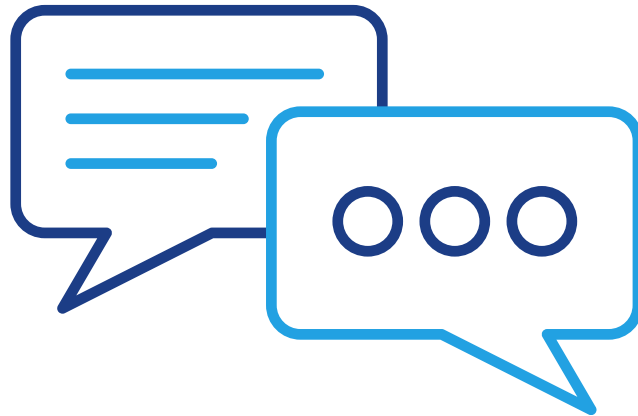


PERSUASIVE TEXTS

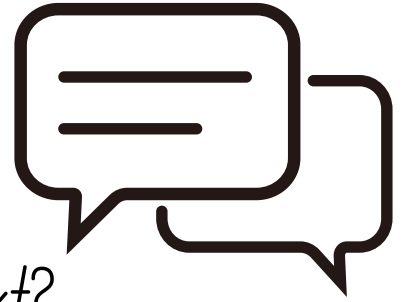
