Title: How to Brush Your Teeth

What You Need:

- Toothbrush
- Toothpaste
- Water
- Towel

## Steps:

- 1. Wet your toothbrush with water.
- 2. Squeeze a small amount of toothpaste onto the brush.
- 3. Brush your teeth in small circles for two minutes.
- 4. Rinse your mouth and toothbrush, then dry your face with a towel.

## Steps:

- Check your timetable to see which books and items you need for the day.
- Place your books and folders neatly at the bottom of your bag.
- · Put your pencil case on top of the books so it's easy to reach.
- Add your lunch box and water bottle to the side compartments.
- · Pack your hat if it's a sunny day or required for outdoor play.
- Zip up your bag and check that nothing is left behind.

#### What You Need:

- Pet food (appropriate for your pet)
- Clean water
- Food bowl
- · Water bowl
- Scoop or spoon
- · A clean area for feeding



#### **YEAR 4: Writing Worksheets**

Activity 3: Sample Answer (How to Feed a Pet)

## Steps:

- 1. Wash your hands before handling any pet food.
- 2. Scoop the correct amount of food into your pet's food bowl.
- 3. Place the food bowl in your pet's usual feeding spot.
- 4. Check the water bowl and fill it with clean, fresh water.
- 5. Call your pet if they haven't already come running!
- 6. Watch your pet eat to make sure everything is okay.
- 7. Clean up any spills and wash your hands again.
